

PREVENT WORKPLACE VIOLENCE

Health care workers are at risk of exposure to violence and harassment in the workplace.

WORKERS:

1. Report potential violence hazards to your supervisor/employer
2. Follow the workplace violence and harassment policies and programs prepared and developed by your employer
3. Know about your right to refuse unsafe work
4. Know what to do when workplace violence occurs



EMPLOYERS/SUPERVISORS

1. Prepare policies with respect to workplace violence and workplace harassment
2. Develop and maintain programs to implement those policies and programs
3. Provide information and instruction to workers on those policies and programs
4. Conduct an assessment of the risks of workplace violence that may arise
5. Provide adequate supervision
